

Subject: **Regarding non-printing of e-visa for Hajj pilgrims.**

The undersigned is directed to inform Your Excellency that e-Visas are not being printed for the pilgrims of many agencies, many of whose flights are very close, some of them for tomorrow and the day after tomorrow. It is necessary that, Pilgrims who are to fly tomorrow and the day after tomorrow, must take immediate steps to get their visas printed from the Royal Saudi Arabian Embassy in Bangladesh. Moreover, it is necessary that there be no problem in printing the Visa of Hajj pilgrims till the end of this Hajj season. Your Excellency, you know, If the visa is not printed in time, there is a possibility of vacancies in the hajj flight.

02. In this context, I would like to request you to take necessary actions to issue Visas for the pilgrims of non-government agencies so that they could get Visas printed on 11/06/2022 and 12/06/2022 (because they are to fly to Saudi Arabia on these days) and oblige thereby.
